## Systematic Review / Meta-Analysis

A Systematic Review/Meta-Analysis identifies and synthesises all published research on a particular topic. We require each Systematic Review/Meta-analysis to be registered through PROSPERO. PRISMA guidelines should be followed when writing, and a completed PRISMA checklist should be included in the submission: <http://www.prisma-statement.org>

- A Systematic Review/Meta-Analysis should be no more than 8 pages in length (1 journal page  $\approx$  3 double-spaced Word pages, Arial 12-pt font) including references, tables and figures.
- Each manuscript should include an abstract, which should follow PRISMA guidance and include the following sections as applicable:
  - Background •Objectives •Data sources •Study eligibility criteria •Participants and interventions
  - Study appraisal and synthesis methods •Results •Limitations •Conclusions and implications of key findings •Systematic review registration number
- There is no abstract word limit.
- The main article should contain no more than 8 tables and figures combined.
- Additional required sections for a Systematic Review/Meta-Analysis may be included as supplementary material to be published online, including long reference lists, evidence tables, supporting data, and other information.
- A Graphical Abstract may be included but is not required.
- Appropriate headings and subheadings are encouraged to make the text easy to navigate.
- References should be listed in order of appearance, and should not normally exceed 100. If you expect to have more than 100 references, please contact a Managing Editor. Citing book chapters is discouraged as these are much less readily accessible to readers.

If you have any questions please contact one of the managing editors. Please note that as with all work submitted to *Pediatric Nephrology*, your manuscript will be subject to peer review.

All manuscripts must be submitted online. You may either use the link on the journal's homepage <http://www.springer.com/medicine/pediatrics/journal/467> or log in to the submission site <http://www.editorialmanager.com/pnep> and upload your manuscript following the on-screen instructions.
