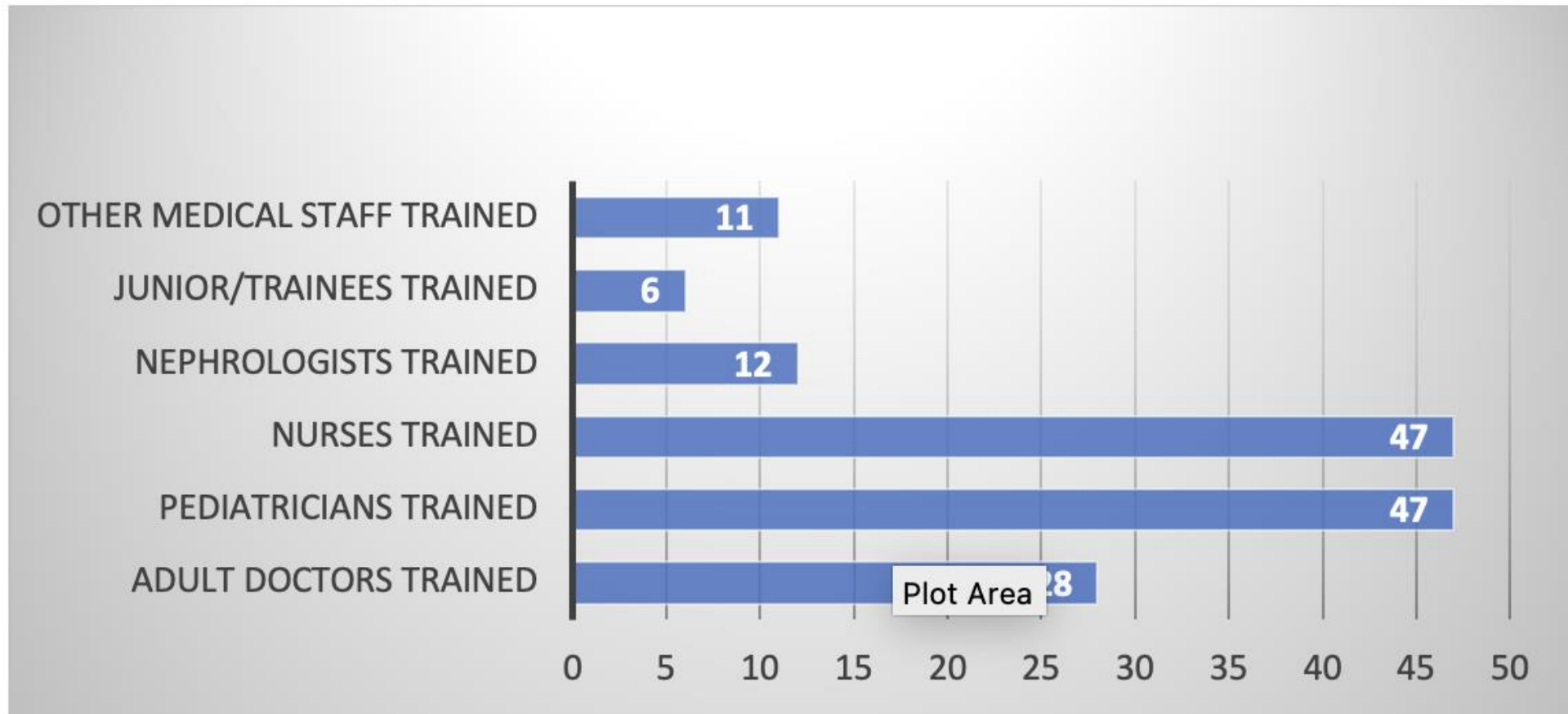
**IPNA Presentation**

**In the 2017-2022 time period, SYL trained 470 individuals in 42 different institutions from 26+ low resource countries.**



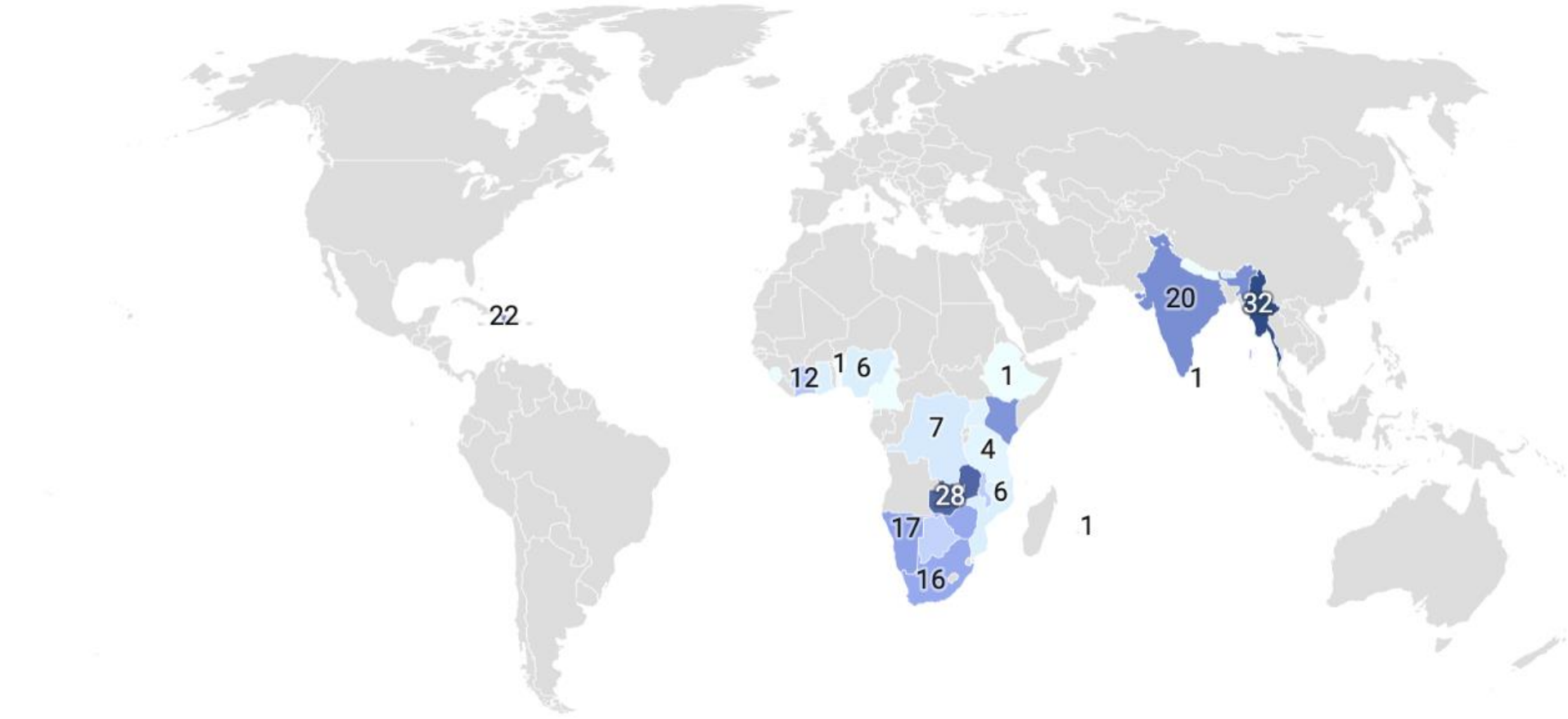
# SYL trains medical teams

Profession of SYL Alumni 2017-2022



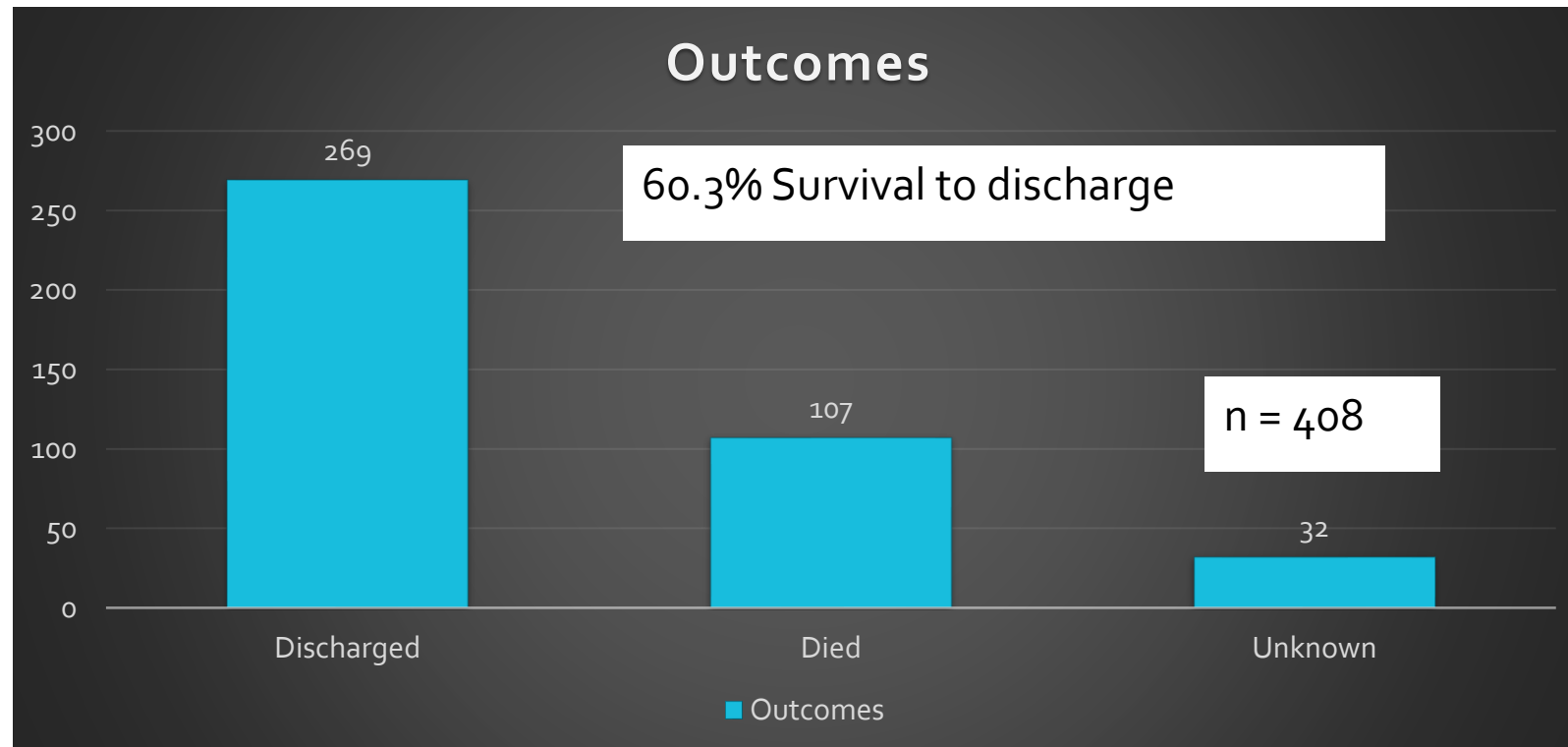
# Location of 2017-2022 SYL trainees

#SYL alumni 2017-2022

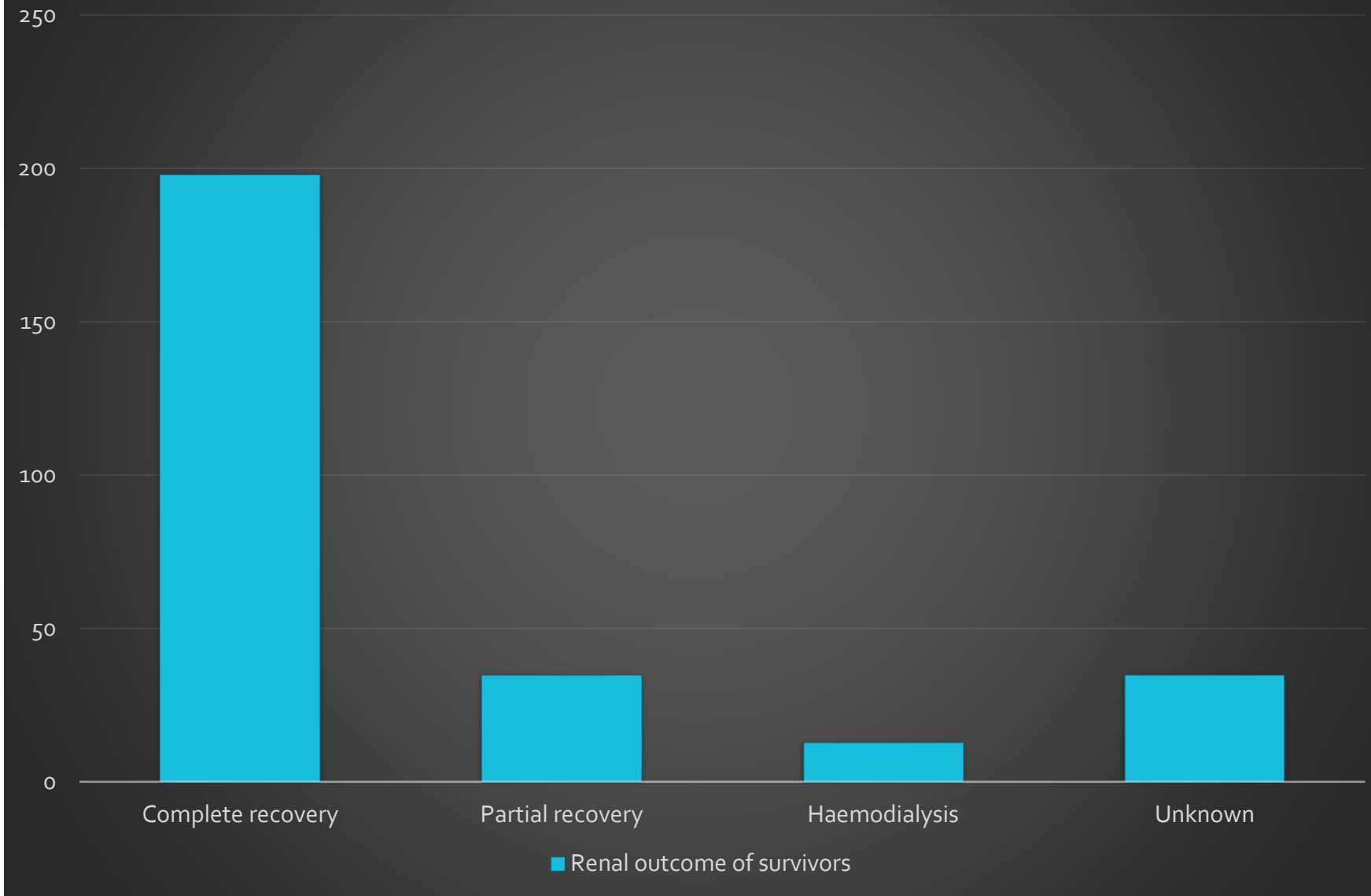


# SYL Patient Outcomes
